<u>Vases</u> – we are collecting old vases to donate with bouquets of flowers to assisted living homes.


<u>Plastic Bread Tags</u> – GFWC Apple Blossom Club is collecting the tags for "Danielle Cares for Chairs."

## **Cleaning Supplies for YWCA**

- Here are some of the supplies the YWCA needs: liquid dish soap, All-purpose cleaner, Clorox disinfectant wipes, Lysol disinfectant spray, hand sanitizer, laundry detergent, laundry fabric softener sheets, Clorox bleach, paper towels, toilet paper, Windex and wash cloths, bathroom cleaner, air deodorizer (Fabreeze), sponges
