If anyone knows anything about what happened to a “Desert Storm” memorial that was installed in the Town Park in the late 1990's, please contact Linda Ritts.

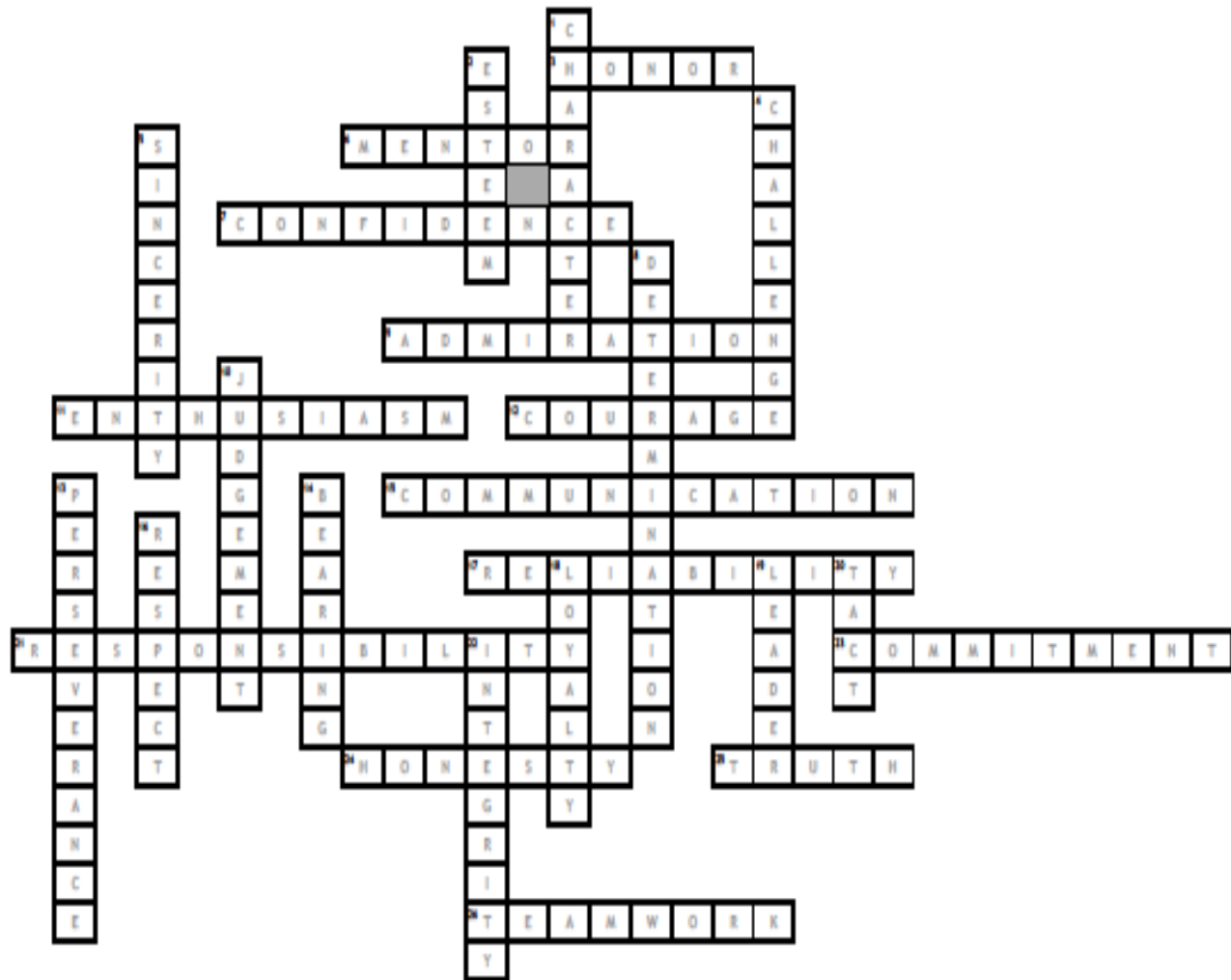
